**ATR VERDICT:** Double Kodiak opened his account at the first attempt at Maisons-Laffitte, but subsequent efforts have left a lot to be desired, while Whelans Way created a favourable impression on debut at Bath but was brushed aside in no uncertain terms at Newbury last time. CRACKIN DREAM seems to be heading in the right direction, following up a Windsor fifth on debut with a much better effort over C&D and Clive Cox's colt is taken to continue that upward trend.
