ATR VERDICT: STOP THE WORLD, a half-brother to Willie Mullins' Grade Two winner Up For Review, was somewhat disappointing given his profile in two bumpers last season, butt his point-to-point second to Brewin'Upastorm, a 250,000-pound purchase who was a leading figure in National Hunt Flat races last season, offers hope of a much improved showing now tackling obstacles. Golden Promise performed well on debut at Worcester last month and could go one better here, while Gwalia chased home useful opponents on all three bumper outings last season and must be respected.
