Capable over 7f or 1m and in varying ground conditions, the eight-year-old is 1-1 at this venue and could prove too strong for the likes of Lord Oberon, who receives plenty of weight but needs to find some improvement. Graphite Storm put in a nice effort at Ascot last time, while Hajjam looks sure to be given a positive ride once more following his dominant Ayr success 24 days ago.
