ATR VERDICT: Mark Johnston fires two bullets here with his consistent Alex Jackson and French Twist, who returns to the scene of her promising debut following a few disappointing efforts since. Swift Justice represents a top team and could improve for the application of a first-time visor, while Pesci went close over course and distance last month and is only 1lb higher now. However, preference is for SMART ILLUSION, who built on his Musselburgh success when third in a competitive Kempton event and he looks sure to be in the firing line again.
