ATR VERDICT: PULSATING has been a little bit of a nomad of late, changing hands to Jamie Osborne for a run at Laytown and now finds herself making her first appearance for Conor O'Dwyer. She was beaten less than two lengths when second at Laytown last time and could easily better that now off the same rating for her new handler. Tyrconnell was a winner on the same card and has since made the podium at Naas. He could have more to come stepping up to seven furlongs, while C&D winner Bouquet Garni has performed well off this mark on the last three occasions and arrives here in good form.
