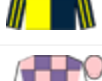

ATR VERDICT: Ride The Monkey scored here over 7f on debut last month and is respected tackling an extra furlong now. However, preference is for FOX LEICESTER, who saw the penny drop in the latter stages at Ascot, running on for third, and the 310,000-euro Dark Angel colt can produce a much more professional performance this time. Any strong market vibes for John Gosden's Dubawi newcomer Lord North should be noted, while Barys was a beaten favourite at Chelmsford last time but still possesses plenty of potential and a step up to a mile is interesting.
