ATR VERDICT: PAPAGANA was seven lengths clear of the consistent Lily Of Leysbourne when they met at Ffos Las in May and, despite being penalised accordingly, she appears the one to beat with Oliver Sherwood's string operating well at present. Outofthisworld impressed when winning a bumper here in March last year and, despite disappointing when well held in Listed company in December, she has to be respected now switching to hurdles. Any market support for Rococo Style would be interesting at Steve Gollings' local track, while L'chamise and Tickerty Boo are others with each-way possibilities.
