ATR VERDICT: Highway One O One often got himself involved at the business end over hurdles last season and, having started life over fences with an eye-catching six-length victory over Cheltenham Festival winner Flying Tiger at Newton Abbot, he has to be given enormous respect here. However, preference is for DR DES, who landed three hurdle races in comfortable fashion last term and almost caused a shock when second in an Ascot Grade 2 over the Christmas period, confirming form in the process with the well regarded Mr One More. Dynamite Dollars was at his best early on in the season last year and this may be the best time to catch him, making his chasing bow for a leading team.
