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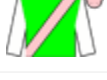
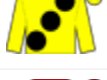

ATR VERDICT: Those with experience make very limited appeal so it should pay to focus on the newcomers. Exoptable is from a top Cheveley Park family and although she is bred for a mile-plus on her dam's side, sire Dark Angel injects plenty of speed. 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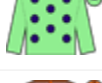

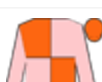
