ATR VERDICT: Paul Nicholls' strapping Kapgarde gelding KAPCORSE became a man when thriving on his chase debut at Bangor in the spring and despite a 12lb hike from the assessor, the progressive five-year-old, who was a comfortable eight-length winner that day, is backed to enhance his reputation in this competitive contest. Fellow youngster Siruh Du Lac can bounce back to his best on a sound surface and this looks the ideal distance for now, while Dicosimo was a Listed winner over hurdles and is well worth trying over the larger obstacles once again. Thomas Crapper makes appeal off a mark 7lb lower than when successful in a C&D Grade 3 in March last year, with De Dollar Man is just 1lb higher than when scoring in an Exeter handicap chase last winter.
