**ATR VERDICT:** Seamus Mullins is double-handed here with the consistent Kentford Heiress and She's Gina, who would have leading claims if in the same form as when scoring at Warwick in the summer. Shambra produced a useful reappearance when second at Stratford, beaten less than two lengths, and has to be respected. However, preference is for SOLSTALLA, who came out on top in that contest and the step in distance here should allow her to extend the winning margin over the aforementioned, with a leading jockey taking over now in the saddle.
