ATR VERDICT: Dual bumper scorer WINDSOR AVENUE is a well regarded gelding and his reputation was done no harm when runner-up first time over hurdles at Carlisle last month, finding only a smart Nigel Twiston-Davies inmate too good. He is entitled to improve for that first outing since February and will take an awful lot of beating stepping up three furlongs in trip. Sheriff Garrett wears cheekpieces for the first time in this code (has worn them twice to victory on the Flat) and looks clear second best, while Western Aussie showed promise between the flags before joining Martin Todhunter.
