ATR VERDICT: Unowhatimeanharry won this prize last year but was unable to get his head back in front for the remainder of the campaign. His stable did have a patchy season, however, and a wind operation along with a summer break could see him return to form. Vision Des Flos returns to hurdles after unseating his rider on chase debut at Ffos Las last month and is an interesting contender having shaped here in April behind Lalor as though this distance would see him to best effect. Agrapart got the better of WHOLESTONE when the pair met in the Cleeve Hurdle at Cheltenham over 3m in January, but there is an argument to be made that the latter is better over intermediate trips. Despite the fact he finished third to Penhill in the Stayers Hurdle in March, that was a slowly-run affair which aided the speedier types and his best performance last season came when beating Agrapart in the Relkeel Hurdle over an extended 2m4f on New Year's Day.
