ATR VERDICT: It is somewhat notable the Brian Hughes partners Keith Dalglish's GLORIOUS LADY and the point-to-point winner could be the answer on her Rules debut for an in-form combination. Oscar Light is an experienced campaigner between the flags and appeals more than the other Irish raider Retrace, while Summer Lightening opened her account on debut in the spring and has to be respected, despite being penalised accordingly.
