ATR VERDICT: Capeland doesn't look the most resolute in a finish but any further rain would boost his prospects, while Buster Thomas appeared a little ring-rusty at Market Rasen back in September but is likely to have benefitted greatly from that outing. Ballinure needs to bounce back after failing to beat a rival home at Newton Abbot last time and this can go to FORTH BRIDGE, who just bumped into some promising types at Uttoxeter last time but travelled well and should enjoy this slight drop in distance.
