ATR VERDICT: JEPECK ran a solid race when dropped to 3m at Exeter when last seen in April and is of serious interest here on stable debut for Anthony Honeyball. The nine-year-old could outstay this field. He makes more appeal than Conas Taoi, who makes his first outing for Christian Williams following a long layoff, and Lunar Flow, who wears the tongue-tie/cheekpieces combination for the first time and looks on a workable mark.
