ATR VERDICT: APPLE'S JADE won this on her first outing last season and Gordon Elliott's top-class mare rates as the one to beat again, with only slight concerns about good ground to overcome. Stablemate Dortmund Park ended last year with an impressive victory in a Punchestown Grade 1 contest for novices over this trip and it will be interesting to see how the mount of Davy Russell gets on in open company, while the third Gigginstown contender, Identity Thief, will be looking to bounce back to the form which saw him land the Grade 1 Liverpool Hurdle in the spring. Arctic Fire won this in 2015 and, along with former Champion Hurdler Jezki, will be looking to prove there is still life in their old bones, while Coney Island is on something of a recovery mission now, with the Grade 1 winner's staying chasing ambitions put on hold for now.
