ATR VERDICT: BALLYOISIN appears in the form of his life and the seven-year-old arrives here unbeaten in three having landed a hurdle race comfortably last time. He was a Grade 3 winner over fences at Killarney in May before thrashing a good cast at Punchestown a month later. Enda Bolger's charge had Woodland Opera eight lengths back in second on that occasion in what looks a strong piece of form, with that rival subsequently landing a Grade 2 at Gowran and finishing second in the JNwine.com Champion Chase at Down Royal. Barry Geraghty is reunited with the Presenting gelding having chosen him over Jessie Harrington's veteran Rock The World and must be the one they all have to overthrow here. Doctor Phoenix is a consistent performer who has to be respected, while Ordinary World often acquits himself well in Graded company and will be a winner at this level over fences at some point if putting his best foot forward.
