ATR VERDICT: MARIENSTAR returned in winning fashion at Worcester last month and is entitled to play a leading part if in the same form over this shorter trip. Bryony Frost takes over in the saddle to remove a valuable 3lb and that lessens the burden of the 6lb rise handed for her recent five-length success. Angels Antics may need it softer than this to be seen at her most effective but has to be respected on the best of her form, including a neck second to the highly-regarded Cap Soleil in Listed company at Haydock. Midnight Target was a Listed winner at Cheltenham in the spring and is respected despite returning off a 5lb higher mark, with the consistent Cotton Jenny also respected.
