ATR VERDICT: Lucinda Russell holds a strong hand here with the 10-year-old Mumgos Debut, who was second off this rating last time, and SEVEN DEVILS, with the mount of stable jockey Derek Fox finding himself 3lb lower than when scoring over fences last season and arrives here in decent form.
