ATR VERDICT: Zalvados can leave his comeback effort in the Grade 3 Silver Trophy well behind now dropped in class, while Casterly Rock merits consideration following his reappearance at Bangor. The vote, however, goes to NAYATI. Alan King's charge won two of his three starts last season and returned with an encouraging effort in class 2 company at Chepstow last month, finishing third behind subsequent winner Grand Sancy. Dropped in grade for his second outing this term, he should remain competitive off 2lb higher.
