ATR VERDICT: Impressive point winner HONEYSUCKLE was bought for 110,000 euros following her 15-length demolition between the flags and makes plenty of appeal on her first start under Rules for Henry de Bromhead. The horse in second that day, Annie Mc, has placed on both of her outings in Britain since joining Jonjo O'Neill, mixing it with some useful mares, and hopes must be high the expensive four-year-old can prove to be just as useful in this sphere. Fizzlestick and Venta Garcia both made respectable debuts over timber and could have more to offer, while Our Roxane has looked a lot more comfortable up in trip the last twice and her experience can't be discounted here.
