ATR VERDICT: ARCTIC OCEAN derived considerable benefit from her initial experience at Newmarket because she stepped forward to go close at Chelmsford, and the rise from 7f should see Sir Michael Stoute's Camelot filly in an even better light. Filles De Fleur struggled at HQ but is more effective on the all-weather if her debut second here is anything to go by. Navadir and Abanica have shown enough to warrant a mention, with 350,000gns yearling Kimblewick the most appealing of the unraced brigade.

ATR VERDICT: Glorious Charmer scored with plenty up his sleeve at Yarmouth, finishing off his race really well, so the extra furlong shouldn't be a problem. A 5lb rise isn't unduly harsh either but he is still passed over in favour of INTRICATE, who was disappointing in a C&D novice contest but her first two runs were better and an initial mark of 72 makes her very appealing, with the application of blinkers a source of potential improvement. Spell is another nursery newcomer with claims, and Tin Hat is consistent for all that the handicapper just about has his measure.
